The PIARA-UMN field school is an intensive learning experience that provides training in a variety of archaeological methods, including excavation, bioarchaeology, artifact analysis, GIS, and 3D photogrammetry mapping. In 2019, students will examine monumental temple spaces and tombs at the ancient site of Hualcayán (2400 BC–AD 1450).



During fieldwork, participants will live in a Quechua-speaking indigenous community, travel to museums and archaeological sites, and receive 6 credits from the University of Minnesota.
